Introduction

The purpose of Rapid Response services and Layoff Aversion strategies, is to promote economic recovery and vitality by developing an ongoing, comprehensive approach to identifying, planning for, and responding to layoffs and dislocations to prevent or minimize their impacts on workers, businesses, and communities.



WARN Threshold

Key Requirements	
Length of Notice	60 days; Except in the event of unforeseen business circumstances, natural disaster, or a faltering company, in which case they give notice as soon as possible following the event.
# of Employees needed to justify WARN	100 or more full time employees not including employees who have been on the job less than 6months or workers who average less than 20 hours per week.
Mass Layoff Requirement	Layoff of 50 or more full time employees with a percentage of 33% or more of the total workforce affected OR layoff of 500+ people at a single site in a 30-day period
Plant Closing Requirement	Closing resulting in layoff of 50 or more full-time employees at a single site, during a 30-day period
