




- Demographics impacts the long-term projections:
  - Civilian noninstitutionalized population and labor force are projected to grow more slowly in the next 10 years.
  - Older workers are projected to be a larger percent of the labor force in 2031.

- Growing:
  - Leisure & Hospitality (but to mostly recover towards 2019 levels)
  - Health Care & Social Assistance
  - Construction (modestly)
- Not Growing:
  - Manufacturing to remain flat
  - Retail Trade largest projected decline.



#### Occupation trends:

- Growing:
  - Healthcare Support
  - Computer & Mathematical
  - Personal Care
  - Food Preparation & Serving Related
- Declining:
  - Office & Administrative Support
  - Production
  - Sales & Related

#### WORD OF CAUTION

- 2020 2030 Projections were developed from Feb 2022 June 2022 using historical data through 2020
  - That means we didn't have 2021 data
- As a result, we made enhancements



#### **ENHANCEMENTS**



- 'Step Ahead' we will update the projections' base year to use 2021 data and still project out to 2030
  - This will not project out of trough.
    - Growth rates are more modest
    - Some long-term projections changed more than others, especially in Leisure & Hospitality
- SOC vintage 2018 occupations were utilized!
- Sub-state projections will also have this enhancement and will be produced with a 2021-2030 time frame (May 2023)

Every year, the North Carolina Department of Commerce studies national, statewide, and local economic trends to produce long-term and short-term employment projections for state and sub-state areas. Based on historical data, these projections provide a guide for how the state's economic landscape may evolve given the recent economic trends. The current statewide projections cover the years 2021 to 2030. Substate projections for the same period are expected to be released in May 2023. Their associated tools (e.g. interactive dashboard, searchable table) will be updated at that time.

North Carolina Star Jobs is a new and simplified way to help you identify promising occupations. Star ratings are assigned based on wages, projected growth rate, and projected job openings, and each occupation has a rating of between one and five stars. Occupations with five stars are considered to have much better career prospects than occupations with fewer stars.

#### 2023 Star Jobs

We have developed the 2023 Star Jobs based on the <u>2021-2030 Occupational</u> <u>Projections</u>. The 723 rated occupations statewide were rated based on a slightly updated methodology.


