### Year in review Data revisions

Why are we waiting until March 2024 to talk about what happened in 2023?

- Economic data is published at a lag
  - December 2023 data weren't published until early 2024
- Economic data can be subject to large **revisions** 
  - Revisions are needed to incorporate information that wasn't available when the preliminary data were initially published

Employment data revisions for North Carolina were released last week

Some of these revisions meaningfully impact what we thought we knew about job growth in North Carolina...

### Year in review Key economic trends of 2023

In 2023, our primary questions about the economy focused on the **labor market**, **price inflation**, and the risk of an **economic recession**:

- Will the labor market **cool off** and approach a more **sustainable balance** between employers and jobseekers?
- Will price growth slow to the Federal Reserve's **2% target**?
- Will the economy ease into a **soft landing** (lower inflation and low unemployment) or will it crash into a **hard landing** (recession)?

# Trends to watch in 2024

Will the **labor market** settle into a "**normal**" balance between employers and jobseekers? Or will conditions **deteriorate**?

• Might we start to see more widespread layoffs and more joblessness?

Will price inflation continue to decline? Or will it remain stuck above 2%?

When will the Federal Reserve start to lower interest rates?

• In the meantime, how will higher interest rates impact households and businesses?
