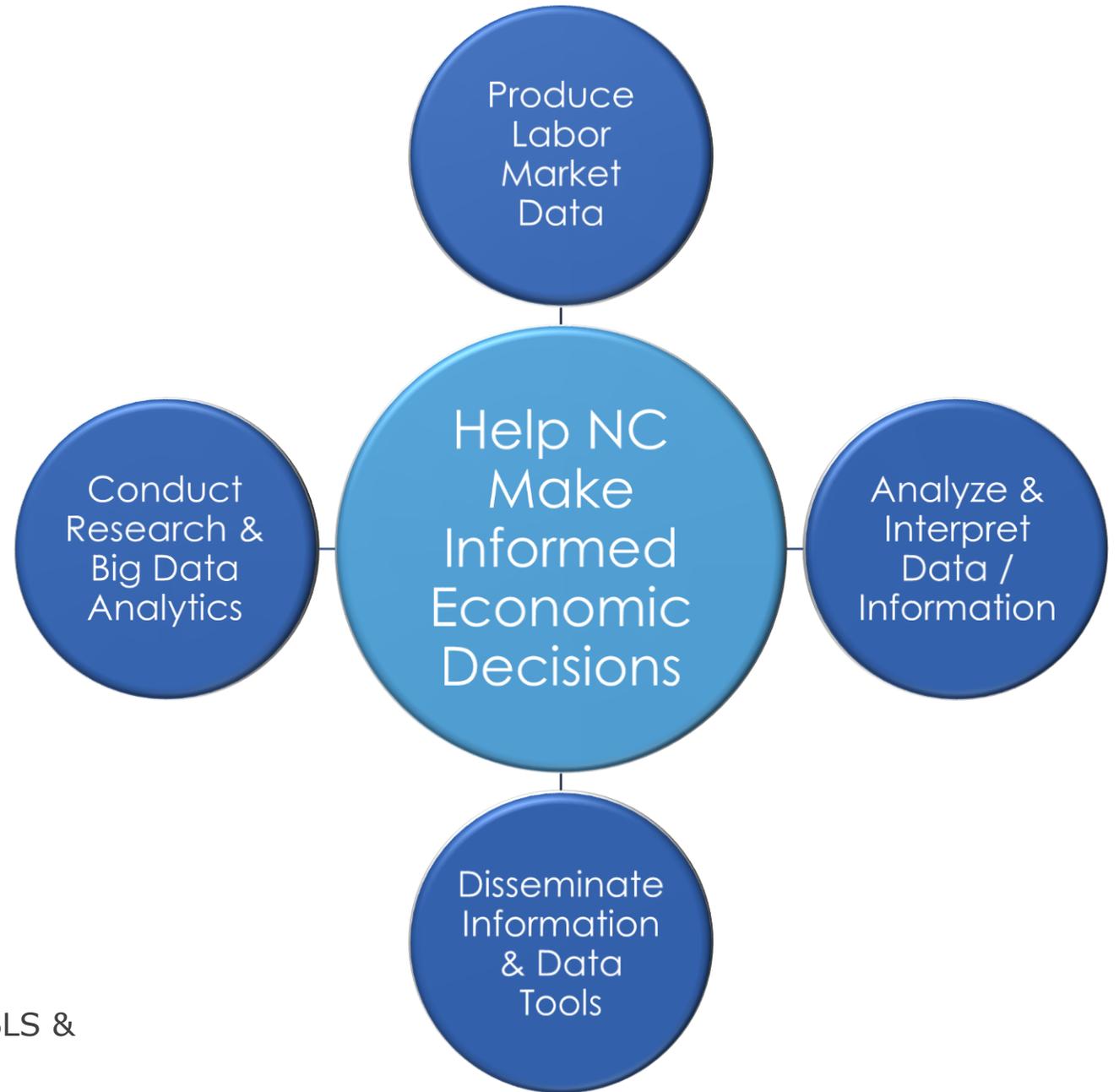

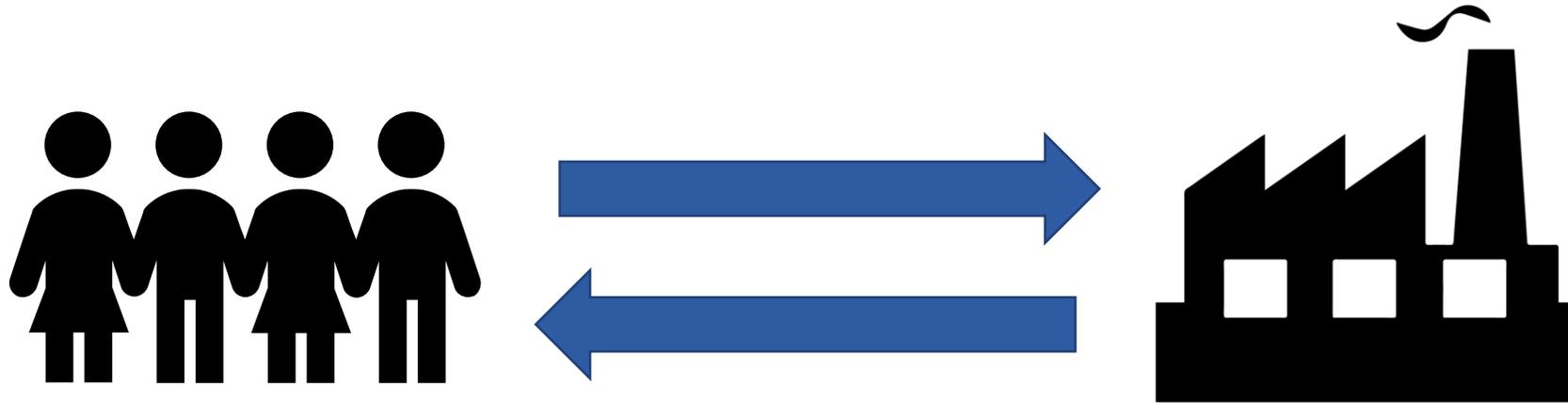
What's the Culture?
