## **Allowable Uses of Industry Sector Partnerships Planning Grants Funding**

All sector partnership activities administered by local workforce area staff and workforce partners must be consistent with applicable sections of WIOA law, Division of Workforce Solutions (DWS) Policies, specific Workforce Development Board (WDB) Policies, and Uniform Grant Guidance.

Awarded Industry Sector Partnerships Planning Grants must be used for the planning and support of new and existing Advanced Manufacturing Sector Partnerships. Sector Partnership funds may be expended on the below allowable expenses related to sector partnership activities as authorized under 20 CFR Part 680. No matching funds will be required. Please note that NC Department of Commerce staff are able to support grant recipients with any data collection needed.

Sector Partnerships allowable and unallowable activities include, but are not limited to, the activities listed in the table below:
