





Current Events



The Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program (DVOP) specialist

• The Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program (DVOP) specialist works directly with veterans and eligible persons who have significant barriers to employment, as identified in 38 USC 4103A(a)(1).

• The services provided by a DVOP specialist are referred to as individualized career services. These services include, but are not limited to:

- Comprehensive assessment interviews
- Career guidance services (e.g. for VR&E)
- Individual Employment Plans (IEPs)
- Labor Market Information (LMI) (e.g. for VR&E)
- Some other responsibilities that DVOP specialists have are:
- Case Management (e.g. for VR&E) and Outreach Services to veterans.
- 72 Hours Contact with 3 unsuccessful attempts will terminate



Local Veterans' Employment Representatives (LVERs) Consolidated (DVOP specialist & LVER position)

Local Veterans' Employment Representatives (LVERs) advocate for all veterans served by the American Job Centers (NCWorks Career Centers) with business, industry, and other community-based organizations by participating in appropriate activities such as:

- Planning and participating in job and career fairs
- Conducting employer outreach
- In conjunction with employers, conducting job searches and workshops, and establishing job search groups
- Coordinating with unions, apprenticeship programs, and businesses or business organizations to promote and secure employment and training programs for veterans
- Informing federal contractors of the process to recruit qualified veterans
- Coordinating and participating with other business outreach efforts
- Consolidated Staff positions perform <u>both</u> the duties of a <u>DVOP specialist</u> and <u>LVER</u>.


