WHEREAS, an increasing number of students, dislocated workers, and mid-career professionals are seeking NCWorks Certified Career Pathways to attain requisite training and skills; and

WHEREAS, NCWorks Certified Career Pathways provide comprehensive opportunities for training, retraining, work-based learning, and credentialing; and

WHEREAS, NCWorks Certified Career Pathways support the NC Job Ready workforce development initiative by promoting skills and education attainment, leveraging employer leadership, and encouraging local innovation; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina is committed to matching worker preparation to employer need in high-demand, high-wage industry sectors; and

WHEREAS, the NCWorks Commission has certified 35 career pathways statewide to aid the State's workforce development efforts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim January 28 – February 1, 2019, as "NCWORKS CERTIFIED CAREER PATHWAYS WEEK" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
