Subject: Priority of Service for Veterans and Eligible Spouses in all U.S. Department of Labor Job Training

Purpose:

To emphasize to staff of local Workforce Development Boards, Division of Workforce Solutions Offices, and NCWorks Career Centers provisions of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Final Rule for Priority in all federally-funded training and employment programs as prescribed in the Jobs for Veterans Act, and to provide instruction on the implementation of the provisions. To rescind DWS Policy Statement Number PS 12-2014.

Background:

The Jobs for Versians Act, Dublic Law 107, 288, was righted into law on Neverther 7, 2002. One provision of the Jobs for Vet rans Act, codified at 38 U. I.C. 8, 2215 establishes a princit of service requirement for covered persons (i.e., veterans and eligible spouses, including widows and widowers, as defined by this statute) in qualified job training programs. Relevant documents are provided as attachments.

Action:

All appropriate staff must be aware of and comply with Priority of Service for Veterans and Eligible Spouses Final Rule, effective January 19, 2009. Local Workforce Investment Boards will develop policies implementing priority of service for the One-Stop Career Centers and other service delivery providers in their strategic local plan. This Policy and attached documents must be maintained on file and made available to all USDOL/Veterans Employment and Training Service (VETS), and other federal and state personnel conducting office audit reviews.
