Dislocated Worker Fund Allocations Rescission**

Purpose: To transmit Revised Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Program Year (PY) 2015 Local Area Allocations to Reflect Rescission.

Background: The U.S. Department of Labor released Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Allotments for PY 2015 (July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016) for Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Activities in Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 29-14, Change 1. The state allotments are based on funds appropriated to the U.S. Department of Labor by the United States Congress.

This Policy reflects Congressional action contained in the short-term Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2016, H.R. Resolution 719, enacted on September 30, 2015, which requires the U.S. Employment and Training Administration to *adjust downward* the Fiscal Year 2016 “advance” funding levels (funding available October 2015) for the WIOA Adult and Dislocated Worker programs.

The attached charts now reflect the rescission of funds of the October portions of the Program Year 2015 Local Area Adult and Dislocated Worker allocations.

Also, included for convenience, is the original Chart for Youth allocations, which has remained unchanged.

Action: The attached allocation charts are to be used for planning and operating local Program Year 2015 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act programs under the PY 2015 Local Area Plans. Funds will be administered through the Workforce Information System Enterprise (WISE) system.
