

- **Purpose:** To transmit the income chart identifying the higher of the Federal Poverty Level Income Guidelines and the 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level guidelines.
- On January 24, 2013, the Federal Register posted notice of the 2013 U.S. **Background:** Department of Health and Human Services (DLHS) Poverty Guidelines. The U.S. Department of Labor published Lowe Living Standard Income Levels (LLSIL) in the Federal Register March 19, 2013. The LLSIL is used for several purposes under ne Workforce Investment Act (WIA). Specifically, WIA Section 101(25) defines the term "low income individual" for eligibility purposes, and Sections 107(b) (b) (c) and 132(b)(1)(B)(v)(IV) define the terms "disadvantaged youth' and "disadvantaged adult" in terms of the poverty line or LLSIL for State ormula Allotments. North Carolina and local Workforce Development Boards use the LLSIL for determining eligibility for Youth and engoility or employed Adult workers for certain services WIA. Section 101(4) defines the LLSIL as "that income level (adjusted for regional metropolitan, urban and rural differences and family size) determined annually **b**, the U.S. Secretary of Labor based on the most recent lower living family budget issued by the Secretary."
- Action: Workforce Investment Act Local Workforce Development Areas are to use the attached 2013 Income Chart to determine low-income status of applicants for WIA services as defined in the WIA Legislation at Section 101(25).
