Subject: NCWorks Mobile Career Center No Cost usage

Agreement and Fee-for-Use Schedule

Purpose:

To provide guidance on the NCWorks Mobile Career Center's expanded no cost usage agreement and update fee-for-use schedule. To rescind DW-PS 09-2015 "Mobile Unit's expanded no cost usage agreement and updated fee-for-use schedule."

Background:

The North Carolina Division of Workforce Solutions and the Corthwest Piedmont Workforce Development Board have agreed on the T. Wo. Mobile Career Center's expanded no cost usage and lowered fee-focuse screedale that applies to the Unit owned by either the Division or Workforce Board. The Livision has further entered into an agreement with the Board to provide Repid response, Business Connections and Community Resources to designated areas of the stan with their respective Mobile Unit. Please see attachment 1.

Rapid Response services are derived as ctivities that are necessary to establish comprehensive services from agency business announcement or a WARN notified layoff, downsizing, and/or business closure. Rapid Response services are also provided to workers displaced due to a nature disaster. Some career services provided at Rapid Response related events may in lude employee orientation sessions, Job Seeking Skills Workshops, job and common tyresource fairs, NCWorks online registration and humanitarian assistant to help survivors of natural disasters. Rapid Response services that incorporate the use of a Mobile Unit that meet this definition will be provided at no cost to Workforce Development Boards.

Wo force Decopment Boards may use the Mobile Unit at no cost for Business Corrections to assist new and existing industry with job recruitment, training, job cention and layoff aversion. This may include outreach, assistance with online encoyment applications, testing and screening, new employee orientation, on-the-job training or incumbent worker training.

Workforce Development Boards may use the Mobile Unit at no cost to provide Community Resources for dislocated workers that include returning military service members. Such services may include a job and community resource fair, health fair, Job Seeking Skills Workshops, NCWorks online registration and veteran services. Any Community Resources event that serves a population other than dislocated workers will adhere to the lowered fee-for-use schedule as defined in attachment 2. The fee-for-use schedule was lowered to encourage Workforce Boards to provide Community Resources and host urban or rural events for youth, unemployed or underemployed adults, homeless veterans, former offenders, economically disadvantaged or adults with significant barriers to employment.



Fee for Use

Any Community Resources urban or rural event that serves a population other than dislocated workers such as youth, homeless veterans, unemployed or underemployed adults, former offenders, economically disadvantaged and other adults with significant barriers to employment will adhere to the following lowered fee-for-use schedule:

Full Day

Full day event (4 hours or more) will be invoiced \$200.00 plus mileage at the IRS mileage reimbursement rate (<u>Current rate</u>) if roundtrip is less than or equal to 100 miles. Roundtrip mileage that exceeds 100 miles will be invoiced at \$0.30 per mile.

Half Day

Half day event (less than 4 hours) will be invoiced \$100.00 plus mileage at the IRS mileage reimbursement rate (<u>Current rate</u>) if roundtrip is less than or equal to 100 m less. Roundtrip mileage that exceeds 100 miles will be invoiced at \$0.30 per mile.
